## TOWNSHIP OF OXFORD WORKSHOP MEETING SEPTEMBER 20, 2005

The regularly scheduled workshop meeting of the Mayor and Committee of the Township of Oxford was held on September 20, 2005 in the Township Municipal Building, 11 Green Street, Oxford, New Jersey.

In attendance were Alex Lazorisak, Phil Rosenberg, and Angelo Accetturo.

The meeting was called to order at 8:56PM by Mayor Lazorisak who announced that the meeting had been properly advertised in compliance with the OPMA of 1975.

David Gootee of 141 Buckley Drive asked the Committee for a refund for the sewer connection fee of \$1,010.00 that Oxford Township requires. The previous owner had been paying for sewer and was never connected to the sewer system. All sewer taxes are paid up to and including December, 2004.

On motion by Mr. Rosenberg, seconded by Mr. Lazorisak and passed unanimously on roll call vote, the Committee agreed to waive the first and second quarter of 2005 sewer tax and interest for 141 Buckley Avenue. Mr. Gootee agreed and thanked the Township Committee and everything was resolved.

Kevin Thomsen came before the Committee to discuss the bills that he submitted to be paid. He found that hackers tried to enter the Township Tax Collector's computer and a report will be submitted to the FBI in Newark.

Mr. Rosenberg will meet with Kevin Thomsen next week to discuss monthly fees and a new contract for 2006.

On motion by Mr. Lazorisak, seconded by Mr. Rosenberg, the amount of \$565.00 and \$336.67 were approved for payment. Mr. Accetturo voted No.

Chuck Lilly, Officer In Charge explained to the Township that the State of New Jersey is requiring all breathalyzers be returned to the state as of October 13, 2005. The State is requiring a purchase of the Alcotest 7110MK III-C Breath Alcohol Testing System. This system is mandatory and cannot be shared with State Police or another Township. There are no grants or discounts available at this time. The price of the breathalyzer is \$12,148.00.

On motion by Mr. Lazorisak, seconded by Mr. Rosenberg, and passed unanimously on roll call vote, Mr. Lilly was given authorization to purchase the Alcotest 7110MK.

<u>RESOLUTION 2005-49</u> Emergency Appropriation for \$7,000. Spring Meadows was cancelled on motion by Mr. Lazorisak, Seconded by Mr. Rosenberg and passed unanimously on roll call vote.

<u>RESOLUTION 2005-59</u> Oxford Municipal Alliance Grant for 2006 in the amount of \$3,485.00 was approved on motion by Mr. Lazorisak, seconded by Mr. Rosenberg and passed unanimously on roll call vote.

Mayor Lazorisak wrote a letter to National Asphalt Pavement Association in support of Tilcon application for NAPA's Diamond Achievement Commendation.

Oxford Township received a check for \$6,600.50 from Dennis O'Rouke to finalize the Spring Meadow outstanding escrow balance.

The Code Revitalization Proposal submitted by General Code will be reviewed further and discussed at out October 19, 2005 Township Meeting.

The Oxford Township Emergency Squad request for a search on Block 4, Lot 27 will be researched by Robert Benbrook and questions answered at our next Oxford Township Meeting held on October 19, 2005 at or near 7:30 PM.

The Committee reviewed the September, 2005 Bill and Voucher List. The following bills were withheld:

The balance of the bills as listed on the September, 2005 Bill List were approved by the Committee for payment on motion by Mr. Lazorisak, seconded by Mr. Rosenberg and passed unanimously on roll call vote.
